The Women of the ELCA Triennial Gathering will be held September 21-24 in Phoenix Arizona. Our Theme is "Just Love" and we would love for all women to join us regardless of whether or not you have an active WELCA Unit in your congregation.

The Women of the ELCA's fundraising campaign, **Katie's Fund 2122** seeks to grow our current Katie's Fund Endowment by 1 million dollars in order to significantly increase grants throughout the organization in the areas of Leadership Development, Global Connections and Living Theology. Currently we have raised close to \$ 400,000 of our goal. FROM YOUR AR/OK TREASURER

It was suggested that I refresh your memories on how and where to send you offerings to the AR/OK SWO Treasurer. How and where to send your offerings: use the attached form with your offerings and send to me Jackie Wilson, 6 Aguila Way, Hot Springs Village, Arkansas 71909.

Your **UNIT** offerings (and they should be made quarterly in order to give your board some idea as to the monies coming in) are divided as such: 50% is retained by AR/OK SWO (Synodical Women's Organization) and 50% is sent to CWO (Churchwide). You should record them on Form A and send to me. I will then send 50% to CWO. If you bring them to the convention or Cluster meetings, please insure that you have indicated on the check that this is a "UNIT" offering and use Form A.

For Cluster Spring Gathering offerings, 50% goes to the charity or mission that your cluster has chosen and 25% is sent to CWO and 25% is kept in the AR/OK SWO. Use Form A for this offering. This is why it is important that you indicate on your check whether your unit is making a unit contribution or a Spring Gathering offering.

Convention Offerings are different. 50% is sent to the mission or charity(s) chosen by the SWO and 50% is sent to CWO. AR/OK SWO does not keep any of these offerings. However, if this is a UNIT regular offering, Use Form A and 50% of this is sent to CWO and 50% is kept in AR/OK SWO.

All other offerings such as Thankofferings, Designated and Special Offerings should be mailed directly to SWO with **Form B.**

2023 CONVENTION

The Triennial Convention (for elected voting members) is scheduled for September 19-21, 2023, Phoenix, Ariz. The convention, the highest legislative authority in Women of the ELCA, will be held at the Sheraton Phoenix Downtown. Voting members, elected in the 64 synodical women's organizations, will conduct the business of the organization. They will elect leaders for the 2023-2026 triennium, act on memorials from synodical organizations and resolutions from the floor, approve a budget and much more.

- There will be lots of vendors to visit with, workshops to attend and learn from.


